Treatment Planning

- This measure shows whether patients' treatment plans were developed in a timely manner. It is based on a review of patient records during calendar year 2009.
- The patient's treatment plan serves as a guide for the hospitalization. In order for treatment to be well-coordinated and effective, the initial treatment plan should be developed within 24 hours of admission.



Treatment Planning Measure

Initial treatment plan completed within 24 hours of admission	100% (137 of 137 patient charts reviewed)	No national results to report

Discharge Planning

- This measure shows whether patients' discharge plans were developed in a timely manner. It is based on a review of patient records during calendar year 2009.
- In order to provide for good quality care, health care professionals who will be providing follow-up care after the hospitalization need to know about the patient's condition, treatment provided, and any medication changes during the hospitalization. They also will need to know any recommendations made for continued care.



Discharge Planning Measures

Measure	Brattleboro Retreat Results	National Results*
Post-discharge continuing care plan created	96.18% (126 of 131 patient charts reviewed)	88.63%
Post-discharge continuing care plan transmitted to next provider upon discharge	72.58 % (90 of 124 patient charts reviewed)	78.09%
