Admission Screening

- This measure shows whether patients were screened for admission in a timely manner. It is based on a review of patient records during calendar year 2009.
- Patients are screened for patient strengths, psychological trauma history, substance abuse history, violence risk to self and violence risk to others.



Admission Screening Measure

Measure	Brattleboro Retreat Results	National Results*
Admission screening within 72 hours of admission for: patient strengths, psychological trauma history, substance abuse history, violence risk to self and violence risk to others.	97.62 % (123 of 126 patient charts reviewed)	90.34%

Pain Assessment

- This measure shows whether patients were screened for pain on admission in a timely manner. It is based on a review of patient records during calendar year 2009.
- As part of each patient's care, we ensure their pain is assessed and addressed and acknowledge every patient's right to pain assessment and management while hospitalized.
